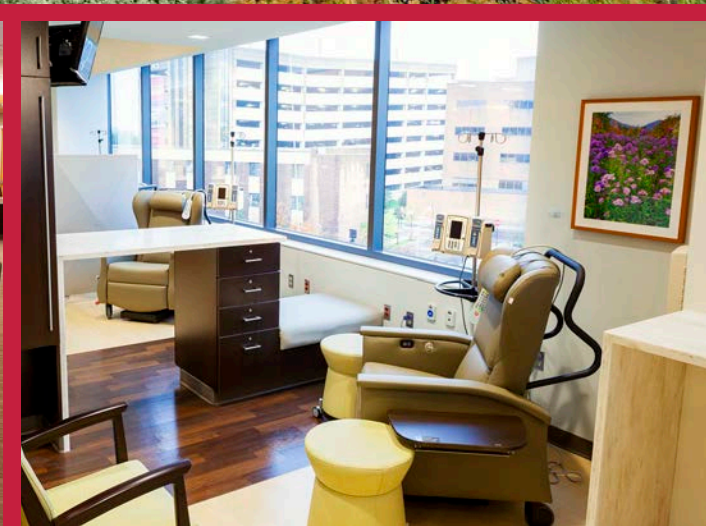
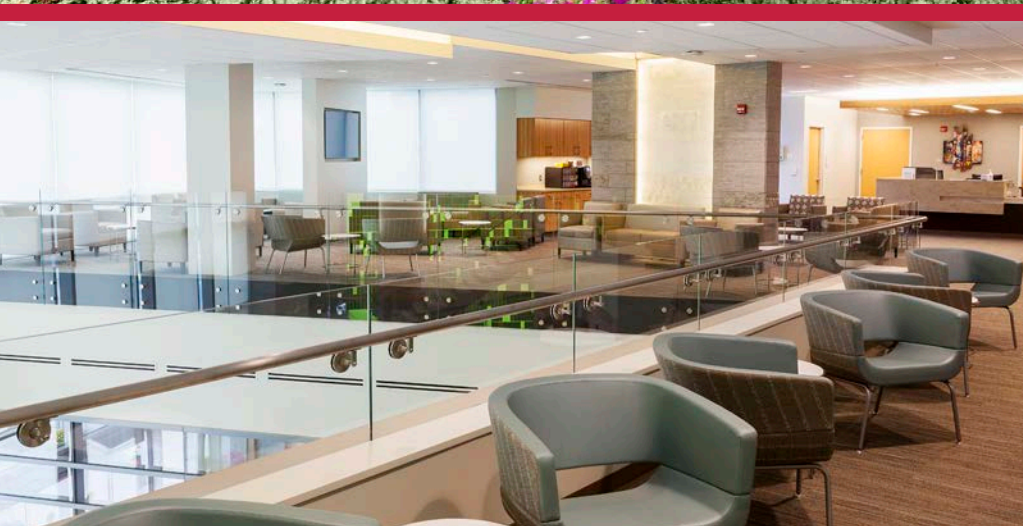

- MD Anderson Cancer Center at Cooper opens in Camden, NJ.



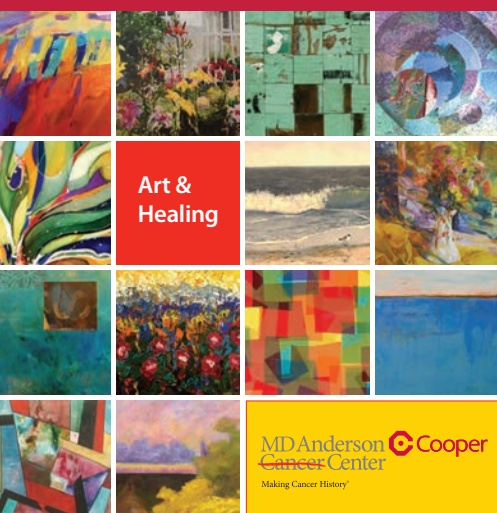

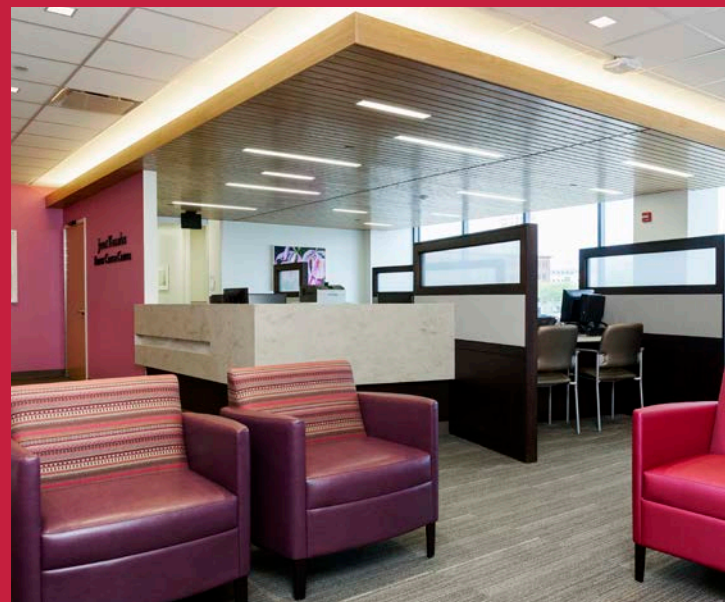

- MD Anderson Cancer Center at Cooper opens the Janet Knowles Breast Cancer Center.
- Team members celebrate Movember by sporting “moustaches” during November to bring awareness to men’s health issues, including prostate and testicular cancer.
- The MD Anderson at Cooper Patient Family Council is formed.
- MD Anderson at Cooper makes specialty cancer medications available to patients through a new Specialty Pharmacy Program.

- MD Anderson Cancer Center at Cooper opens South Jersey's only dedicated oncology inpatient unit, featuring 30 private rooms, oncology-certified nurses, and 24-hour oncology hospitalist coverage.
- The William G. Rohrer Family Foundation donates \$2 million to MD Anderson at Cooper to create the William G. Rohrer Cancer Genetics Program.
- MD Anderson at Cooper is recognized by the Philadelphia Business Journal as one of the *Ten Ways the Philadelphia Region is Changing Cancer Care*.
- MD Anderson at Cooper expands care to its new Egg Harbor Township location.

- MD Anderson Cancer Center at Cooper hosts the American Cancer Society's 80% x 2018 initiative kickoff event committing to boosting colon cancer screening rates by 80% by 2018.
- MD Anderson at Cooper partners with the American Cancer Society and Univision to host "Amate a Ti Mismo" (Love Yourself), a free breast cancer screening event for Latina women.
- Representatives from Subaru of America and local Subaru dealerships visit the MD Anderson at Cooper inpatient unit to deliver blankets to patients — a partnership that continues today.

- MD Anderson at Cooper launches the AeroDigestive Program to care for patients with esophageal cancer and precancerous conditions.



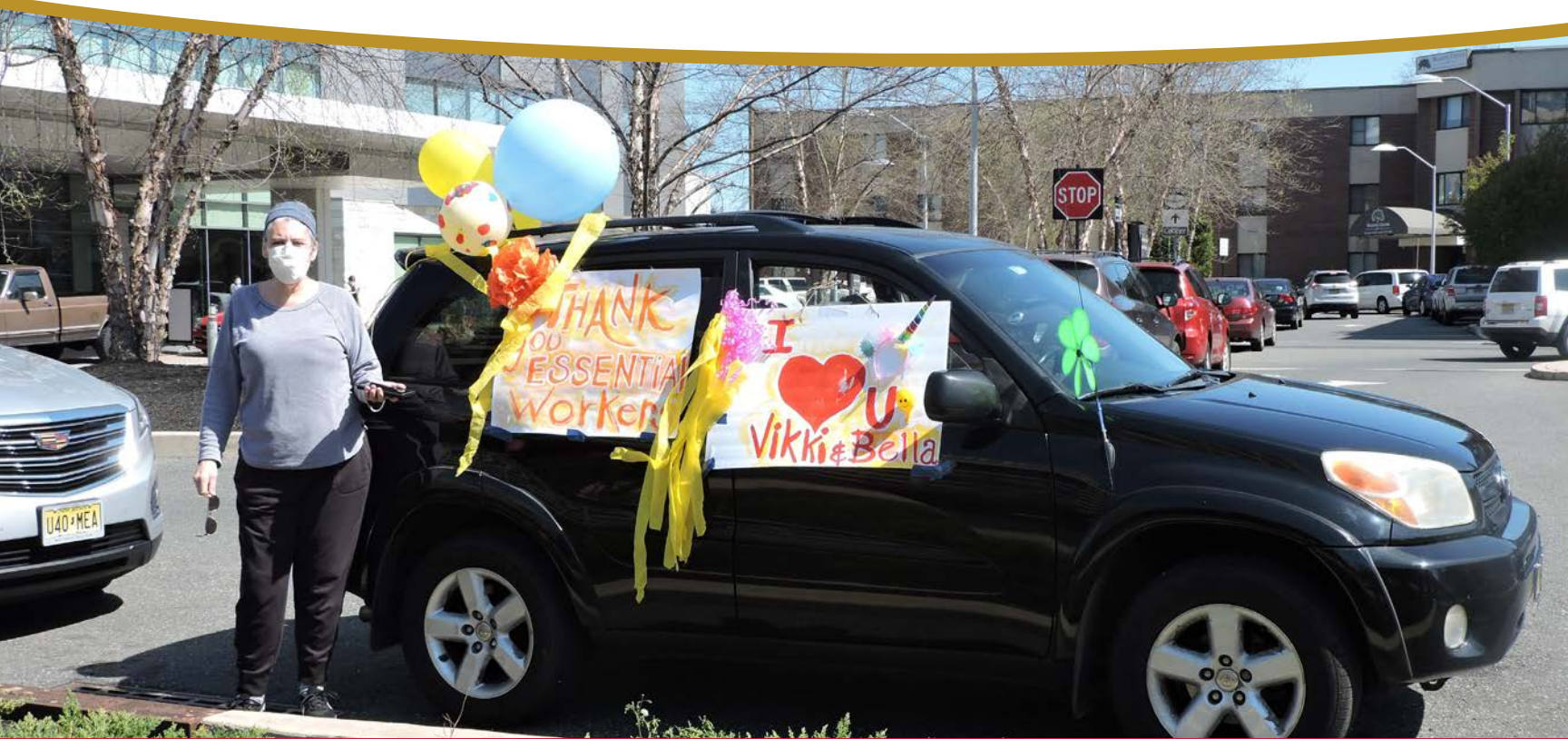

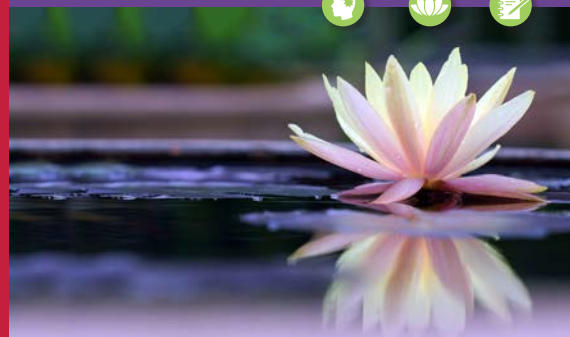

2021



- Cooper University Health Care and Holy Redeemer Health System sign a definitive partnership agreement to create a new, integrated cancer program — Holy Redeemer in partnership with MD Anderson Cancer Center at Cooper.
- MD Anderson at Cooper is one of five centers in the U.S. to treat patients using the MR Linac — a groundbreaking technology that combines the imaging power of a high-resolution MRI device with an advanced linear accelerator.
- MD Anderson at Cooper's Rectal Cancer Program is accredited by the National Accreditation Program for Rectal Cancer (NAPRC) — the first hospital in New Jersey, to achieve this distinction.



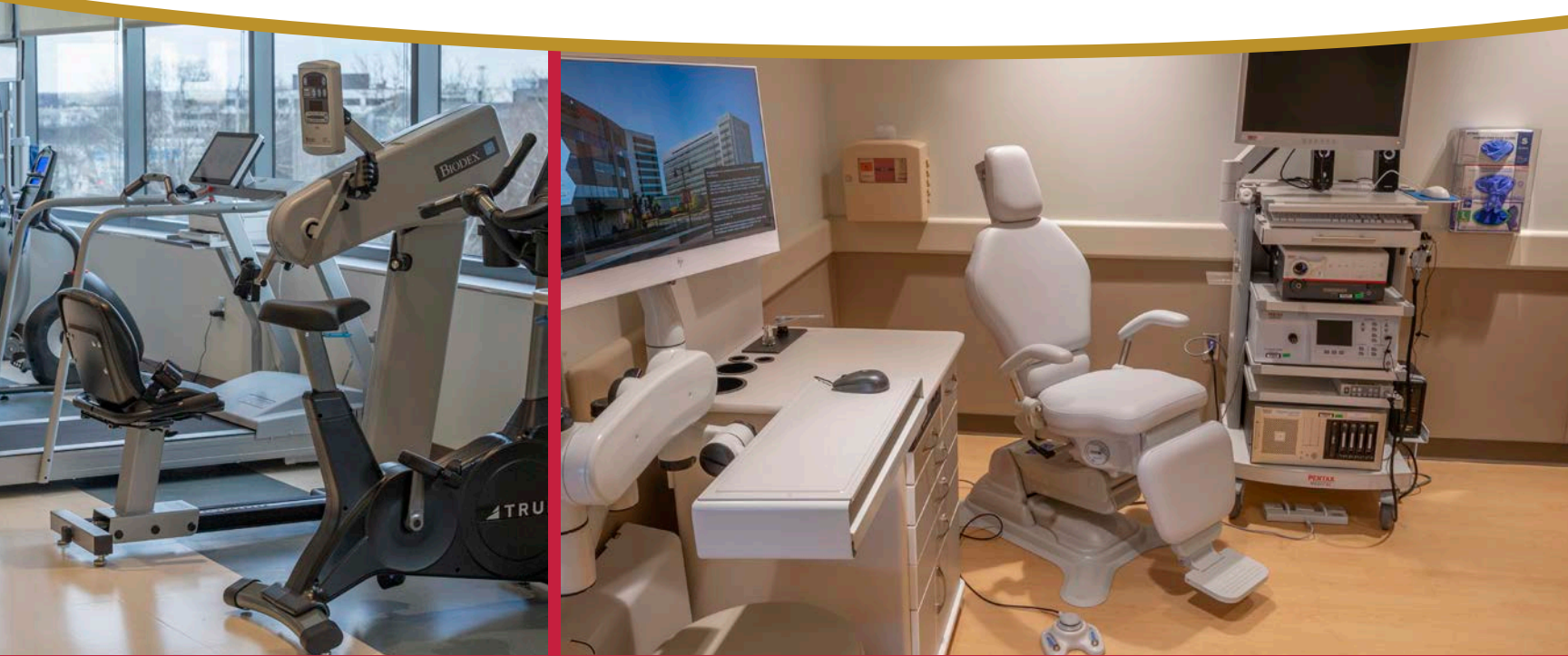

- MD Anderson Cancer Center at Cooper opens a 13,000-square-foot multiservice outpatient unit in Camden. The new unit offers a dedicated malignant hematology clinical suite, a hydration and blood product infusion suite, a physical rehabilitation center, and an Interventional Radiology Suite.
- MD Anderson at Cooper takes part in MD Anderson's Boot Walk to End Cancer® — encouraging patients and team members to wear their boots to work and give cancer the boot.
